Its excuse is the lack of any reasonably comprehensive account of Flaxman's work, and of his place in the history of English art. Fairly adequate biographies exist, however, notably the article by Sir Sidney Colvin in the Dictionary of National Biography and I have therefore refrained from introducing biographical detail except where it has a direct bearing on Flaxman's development and activity as an artist. Of gaps and omissions in my own work I am only too conscious but I hope at least to have provided a starting point for students with greater leisure and opportunities than myself. To acknowledge all the debts incurred in preparing this book would be impossible here. But I am especially grateful to Sir Gregory Foster Provost of University College, for his kindness and help, notably in the matter of publication to Mr...
